## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

Post: Class Teacher

Grade: Main Pay Scale

### **Prime Objectives**

It is expected that you will be an effective member of the school team and that your classroom and teaching practice reflect the school philosophy, ethos and policies and that you will assist in achieving the effectiveness of the agreed aims relating to the curriculum and organisation of the school.

### **Responsibilities**

- To be an excellent classroom practitioner, maintaining a high quality of teaching which will be evident in your classroom organisation and management
- To be responsible for the standard of work and progress made by your children.
- To assess and monitor the progress of your children, meet deadlines for pupil data and contribute to pupil progress meetings.
- To contribute and support the schools positive ethos
- Promote equality of opportunity at every level and actively encourage a sense of community
- To promote good conduct and behaviour within the school
- To have specific responsibilities for the education and welfare of a class of pupils
- To create a stimulating learning environment for the children
- To promote parental involvement and participation
- To supervise on a day to day basis the work of classroom/support assistants allocated to the class
- To comply with health and safety guidance and regulations
- Follow all safeguarding procedures
- To undertake any reasonable duties as may from time to time be specified

Candidates with relevant experience will be expected to contribute to curriculum development throughout the school.

All staff are encouraged to become involved in the wider life of the school including extra curriculum activities.
