To lead and develop issues relating to School Improvement Priorities across the school.

General Duties

As described in the Conditions of Employment of Teachers other than Headteachers.

Specific Duties

- 1. To lead and develop the quality of learning throughout the school, in conjunction with the Senior Leadership Team.
- 2. To play a leading role in monitoring and evaluating the quality of learning and teaching throughout the school.
- 3. To lead a rich and varied programme of school improvement project work throughout the school. This will include specific English, Mathematics, Curriculum and Enrichment projects. The projects will change on an annual basis.
- 4. To promote the improvement of standards in Reading, Writing, Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling, Speaking & Listening and Mathematics as set out in the School Improvement Plan.
- 5. To act in an advisory capacity to colleagues.
- 6. To liaise with other schools and agencies.
- 7. To promote parental interest and understanding within the school's community ethos.
- 8. To keep abreast of curriculum developments and lead the review and development of learning in all curriculum areas.
- 9. To lead CPD in relation to school improvement areas.

10. To work with the Assessment Co-ordinator to help develop the use of assessment to inform and improve learning and moderation of judgements both internally and externally.
